Every culture in the world shares one thing in common: rituals, traditions and observances related to food. When it comes down to it, food is a functional item, it is something that we consume to fulfill the purpose of staying alive. Yet there are many practices around food that go beyond that functional purpose. We use foot in our courting rituals, what's a date without a meal. We use food as a means to share the details of the day, the family dinner table. We use food to communicate our affections in the form of boxes of chocolates, Christmas cookies and more. We also use food to communicate our condolences gathering for meals or bringing food when someone passes. It seems that food is one of our most powerful forms of non-verbal communication. Jesus regularly communicates with his followers, from the wedding at Cana to sharing fish by the sea after the resurrection food is always there. In fact when Jesus speaks to Peter for the last time a food analogy takes center stage

15 When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my lambs." 16 A second time he said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Tend my sheep." 17 He said to him the third time, "Simon son of John, do you love me?" Peter felt hurt because he said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" And he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep." (John 21 15-17)

How is Peter to love Jesus? By feeding his lambs and tending his sheep. Peter had famously denied Jesus three times before the crucifixion and here he affirms Jesus three times, making amends for the past shortcoming. With that amends comes a fresh direction to care for Jesus followers and Jesus uses feeding them to illustrate that point. Peter would go on to be a leader of the disciples as they shared all they had with those in need. I imagine a lot of lambs were fed. There are many ways in which we communicate our care, concern and Christian love for one another, one of those nonverbal ways of communicating that is through food. That is why, since the beginning of the Church, we have been feeding people.


At St. John's we have a new ministry starting. In the Vicar's office is a freezer and every so often we will be getting together to cook food to stock that freezer. The first meals will be lasagna and chicken pot pie. The idea is that if you or someone you know could benefit from a meal, from that nonverbal message of love then feel free to grab a meal. We are hoping that these meals are used when someone is sick, when a loved one passes, when new babies are born or in any other moment where a message of love is needed. Please join us in the Memorial Lounge on Thursday, March 21st at 7:00 PM to discuss Ellen Marie Wiseman's novel, THE LIFE SHE WAS GIVEN.

On a summer evening in 1931, Lilly Blackwood glimpses circus lights from the grimy window of her attic bedroom. Lilly isn't allowed to explore the meadows around Blackwood Manor. She's never even ventured beyond her narrow room. Momma insists it's for Lilly's own protection, that people would be afraid if they saw her. But on this unforgettable night, Lilly is taken outside for the first time—and sold to the circus sideshow.

More than two decades later, nineteen-year-old Julia Blackwood has inherited her parents' estate and horse farm. For Julia, home was an unhappy place full of strict rules and forbidden rooms, and she hopes that returning might erase those painful memories. Instead, she becomes immersed in a mystery involving a hidden attic room and photos of circus scenes featuring a striking young girl.

At first, The Barlow Brothers' Circus is just another prison for Lilly. But in this rag-tag, sometimes brutal world, Lilly discovers strength, friendship, and a rare affinity for animals. Soon, thanks to elephants Pepper and JoJo and their handler, Cole, Lilly is no longer a sideshow spectacle but the circus's biggest attraction...until tragedy and cruelty collide. It will fall to Julia to learn the truth about Lilly's fate and her family's shocking betrayal, and find a way to make Blackwood Manor into a place of healing at last.

Moving between Julia and Lilly's stories, Ellen Marie Wiseman portrays two extraordinary, very different women in a novel that, while tender and heartbreaking, offers moments of joy and indomitable hope.


